SPECIAL PROGRAMS OFFERED AT NOVA

Dual Enrollment

• Opportunity for students to receive both high and NOVA college credit while still being enrolled in high school

Guaranteed Admissions

• NOVA graduates can gain guaranteed admission to more than 40 area colleges and universities when you meet the transfer agreement requirements between NOVA and that university.

ADVANCE

• Partnership between NOVA and Mason that gives NOVA students targeted, personalized support to complete their bachelor's degrees. Once students declare an interest, they are both a NOVA and Mason student; an admissions application for Mason is not req'd.

Year-Up

• 1-year program for students between ages 18-24 with an interest in Cybersecurity, Information Technology, and Business Entrepreneurship. Student complete 1-yr of coursework and a paid internship.

Honors Program

• Offers a curriculum that is challenging and stimulating. Smaller classroom sizes, students facilitate seminar-style discussions. Beneficial for students needing a competitive when applying to 4-year institutions


